Zero Waste: CCSF Refuse Separation Ordinance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>Ordinance Requirements: Sonia</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Effective July 1, 2019 requires Large Refuse Generators in SF to have recycling, composting, and trash audit every 3 yrs</li> <li>○ Large Generators (&gt;40 yd/week OR a roll compactor)</li> <li>○ Courtesy audits offered up until July</li> <li>○ Audit Thresholds                   <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ 5% Compost</li> <li>■ 10% Recycling</li> <li>■ 25% Landfill</li> <li>■ 0% Haz or E-waste</li> </ul> </li> <li>○ June 26th 10am Recology workshop to address FAQ, trainings, etc</li> <li>○ Q1: Will unit training pilot cause UCSF to fail?
