Recycling


- There is no E-waste, regulated medical waste or hazardous waste. (automatic fail).
- There are no food pieces.
- There is no wet/soiled paper or cardboard.
- There are no paper towels, napkins or tissue papers.
- There is no Styrofoam or Styrofoam cups.
- There are no gloves.
- There are no disposable/cloth masks.
- There are no disposable/cloth gowns.
- There are no plastic liner bags/loose plastic film packaging.
- There is no presence of liquid.
- Recycling bin has the correct liner (blue).
