



Greening UCSF's Campus: Paid Part-Time Internship

The Alliance to Save Energy seeks sustainably minded UCSF students!

Are you looking for local ways to address our broad energy and environmental challenges?

The Alliance to Save Energy's Green Campus Program at UC San Francisco (UCSF) is currently recruiting for the 2011 program. We're looking to employ progressive students who are passionate about sustainability and what they can do to help reduce energy and water waste across UCSF campuses.

UCSF Green Campus interns comprise a team of 4-5 students who each commit up to 10 hours per week, compensated at \$11 per hour. The internship runs calendar year 2011 and team members have flexibility in terms of how to structure their weekly hours. Green Campus interns work across campus stakeholders (staff, administrators and students,) to implement campus-based energy/water efficiency projects and related awareness building, in addition to attending weekly team meetings and contributing to effective team dynamics. The 2010 UCSF Green Campus team completed an efficiency inventory of campus owned homes and apartments, in addition to conducting departmental efficiency assessments and related building occupant outreach, identifying more than 470,000 lbs. in avoided carbon emissions, and over \$62,000 in annual electricity/gas savings for the university.

Applicants Must:

- **Be currently enrolled at UCSF**
- Possess excellent written and oral communications skills
- Be an organized self-starter and have excellent time management skills
- Be comfortable with the basic functions of Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel
- Have leadership and teamwork experience
- Be available to commit up to 10 hours/week to a Green Campus internship

Desired Qualities:

- Experience or personal interest in sustainable energy, energy/water efficiency concepts
- Specialized skills such as:
 - Quantitative data analysis (e.g.: developing/populating Excel spreadsheets)
 - Demonstrated ability to learn technical concepts and related skills
 - Graphic design, newsletter design, web design, or editing skills
 - Strong communication: writing and public speaking
- Familiarity with UCSF campuses, staff, administrators and student organizations
