UCSF's Ultra-low Temperature (ULT) Freezer Rebate Program is sponsored by Facilities Services and administered through the Office of Sustainability. The program was established in 2014 with the goal of reducing carbon emissions to achieve the UC-wide goal of carbon neutrality by 2025. This program is designed to mitigate emissions from UCSF-owned buildings and funded through the Facilities Services Utility Budget.
